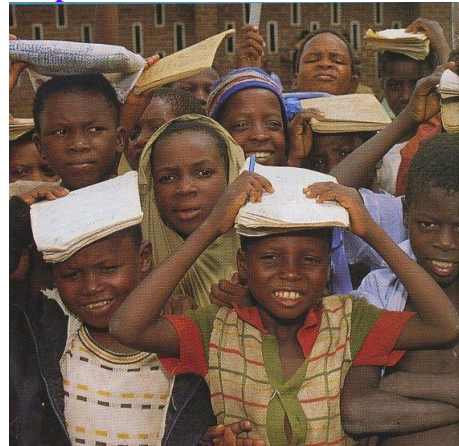


editors' letter
